We understand that some residents / property owners may not be able to take advantage of this service due to limited connectivity.

Receiving your Property Tax and/or Water Bill by email (eSend) will allow you to easily file these important documents electronically for future reference, as well as access these bills wherever you have access to your email. We will see this green initiative as a value added service to residents / property owners in Inverness County.

To sign up for this service, please contact the Municipality at 902-787-3505 or 902-787-3510. Please be sure to have all of your tax / utility account information before contacting the municipality, as you will be asked to confirm your personal account information.

- Each account that has an email address added, will receive one entry into a draw for an Apple iPad.
