The **St. Peter's Samsonville & Area Water Utility**, has made Application to the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board, on behalf of its Water Utility for approval of Amendments to its Schedule of Rates and Charges for Water and Water Services, and Amendments to its Schedule of Rules and Regulations. Specific details of the application are set out below.

**ALL PERSONS** are entitled to attend the hearing.

**ANYONE WISHING TO HAVE FORMAL STANDING** to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses should file such intention with the Board by no later than **Friday, July 7, 2017** and a copy of their written evidence by no later than **Friday, July 28, 2017**.

**ANYONE WISHING TO SPEAK** at the hearing but not wishing to cross-examine witnesses may do so at the hearing. Presentations will follow the order in which interested parties notify the Board of their intention to appear. Such notification is to be given to the Board on or before **Friday, August 18, 2017**.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

For a 5/8 meter, residential customer, the average current quarterly water bill is \$136.08, and it is proposed to increase to \$139.23, (a 2.3% increase) in 2017/18; \$140.17, (a 0.7% increase) in 2018/19; and \$141.00, (a 0.6% increase) in 2019/20.

The Utility is also requesting amendments for other metered services ranging from 1.8% to 2.1% in 2017/18; 1.1% to 1.9% in 2018/19; and -0.6% to -0.3% in 2019/20.

The annual fire protection charge paid by the Village and Municipality, currently \$162,352, is proposed to be amended to \$163,240, (a 0.5% increase) in 2017/18; \$168,960 (3.5% increase) in 2018/19; and \$173,847 (a 2.9% increase) in 2019/20.

Upon reviewing the Application, the Board, in its decision, may determine that the proposed amendments to rates should be as requested, higher, or lower.
