### Town of Port Hawkesbury ANNUAL FALL HYDRANT FLUSHING AND MAIN PROGRAM

The Port Hawkesbury Water Utility wishes to advise our customers that fire hydrant flushing of water mains will begin October 22 and continue to November 3. This activity will occur in all areas of the Town of Port Hawkesbury served by the Port Hawkesbury Water Utility.

**This work will take place between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday to Friday, until completion. Hydrant flushing activities are carried out during overnight hours to cause the least amount of inconvenience for Port Hawkesbury customers.**

Discoloured water and pressure fluctuations may occur during the flushing program. If discolouration of water occurs, it will not pose a health risk, and should disappear shortly. Customers are advised to visually check the water before use during the flushing time frame.

The Port Hawkesbury Water Utility is working to ensure that your water system is ready for peak fall use. The hydrant and distribution system flushing program provides a fall cleaning and full exercise of the entire distribution system.

### Driller

Under the immediate direction of the Pit Foreman, the Driller is responsible for the safe operation of mining equipment in the production of granite products. This is a driller position but the role would be required to perform other mining related duties as assigned.

- Maintains a safe work environment and adheres to all safety rules and regulations
- Must be safety conscious, dependable, motivated and possess a positive attitude in working with others as a team
- Must be able to read and write and speak fluently in the English language
- Must be able to handle varied workloads
- Knowledge of hazards associated with areas of responsibility
- Must have excellent work ethic and safety record
- Ability to be on call or work extended hours when required

### Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Safely operating a drill in the mining process of drilling the blast design layout
- Document daily tasks including maintenance, operation, and drill logs
- Perform daily inspection of equipment and perform minor preventative maintenance tasks
- Operate other equipment periodically; this could include operating haul trucks, loaders, skid loaders, stationary processing plant equipment, and other mining equipment

- Perform other mining/maintenance activities when necessary

### Physical Requirements
