

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT Council of the Town of Antigonish intend to consider and, if deemed advisable,

- enter into a development agreement to allow for the development of a ten-unit apartment building by development agreement at 56 Highland Drive for property PID #01221290, including that a six foot fence be erected to create a light barrier from the parking area adjacent to the neighbouring property;
- amend the Municipal Planning Strategy to clarify that Policy UDH12 allows heritage buildings be considered for a use otherwise not permitted in the zone in effect by development agreement;
- amend the Land Use By-law to count any area intended for parking as hard surface coverage;
- amend the Land Use By-law to prohibit vinyl siding in the Downtown Mixed Use (MU-1)


