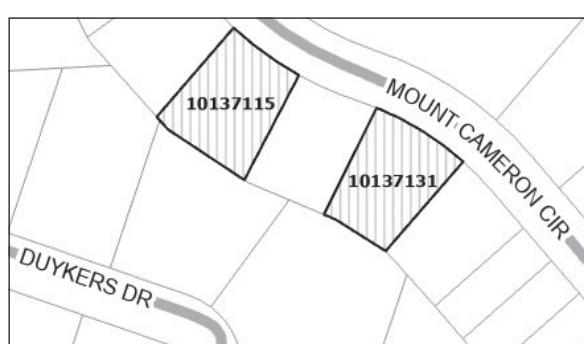

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING



PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT Council of the County of Antigonish intends to consider and, if deemed advisable, to:

- Amend the Eastern Antigonish Land Use By-law to rezone a portion of 385 East Tracadie Road, PID 01252956, East Tracadie from Rural (R-1) to Residential Multi-unit (R-2).
- Redesignate the property identified as PID01212117 from Rural Development to Commercial under the West River Antigonish Harbour Municipal Planning Strategy Generalized Future Land Use Map, and to rezone the same property from Local Commercial (C-1) Zone to the General Commercial (C-2) zone on the West River Antigonish Harbour Land Use By-law Zoning Map, and for the addition of small-scale automobile sales as a permitted use in the General Commercial (C-2) Zone in the West River Antigonish Harbour Land Use By-law.
- Rezone PID10137115 from the Residential (R-1) Zone to the Residential Multi-Unit (R-2) Zone of the West River Antigonish Harbour Plan Area to allow for the construction of a fourplex, and for the rezoning PID10137131 from Residential Multi-Unit (R-2) Zone to the Residential (R-1) Zone.
- Rezone 1648 Addington Forks Road, Addington Forks, Antigonish County (PID 01210582) from the Local Commercial (C-1) and Rural General (RG-1) Zone to the Residential (R-1) Zone.

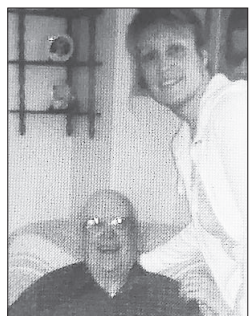

PUBLIC NOTICE

Canadian Navigable Waters Act

Neil Pengelly (Owner) hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Navigable Waters Registry pursuant to the Canadian Navigable Waters Act for public comment described herein and its site and plans.

Pursuant to paragraph 10(1)(b) of the said Act,

Owner has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<https://common-project-search.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 12174 a description of the following work, its site and plans:

Floating walkway 4.75 ft wide by 265 ft long from lot number 75224071 to lot number 75224089 across Rory's Pond at 4024 St. Peters Fourchu Rd, St. Esprit, NS.

Floating walkway constructed with HDPE plastic cubes, held in place with 3" galvanized steel pipes driven into the ground every 10 metres with a 16 ft long aluminum walkway at each shoreline. A 7 ft long aluminum gangway in the middle can be raised to allow boats to pass through.

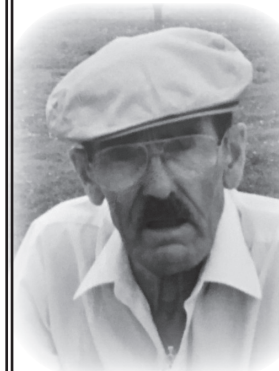

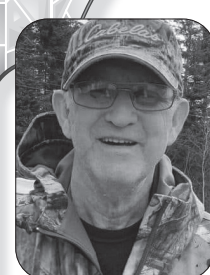

- knowledge of the history of the county
- interest in helping preserve the built heritage of the municipality
- be an active member of a historical society in the municipality
- demonstrated previous concern for the preservation of properties with historical significance
- knowledge of the Standards and Guidelines for the Conservation of Historic Places in Canada
- ability to receive correspondence by email, access digital documents in MS Word, Excel, or pdf formats, and have a working knowledge of computers
