Position Scope: Under the direction and supervision of the Executive Director, the Outreach Counsellor will work towards the development and delivery of services in rural communities involving gender based violence. This new pilot position is part of the larger Leeside team that also includes both Youth and Men's Supports. The community outreach services will include: safety planning, support counselling, crisis intervention, advocacy, and collaboration with other community agencies. This new pilot position will be coordinating & supporting both preventative educational programming and public education campaigns as required. They will be responsible for maintaining accurate records, participating in professional development opportunities, and staffing outreach spaces. They will be working collaboratively with other agencies, such as; Schools Plus, RCMP, Restorative Justice, Departments of Justice/Opportunities/Social Development, Early Intervention, Local Schools, Public Health, Mental Health & Addictions, and other community partners as required.

Overview of Typical Duties:

- Counselling: Supportive and distress counselling.
