Position Scope: Under the direction and supervision of the Executive Director, the Outreach Counsellor will work towards the development and delivery of services in rural communities involving gender based violence. This new pilot position is part of the larger Leeside team that also includes both Youth

and Men's Supports. The community outreach services will include: safety planning, support counselling, crisis intervention, advocacy, and collaboration with other community agencies. This new pilot position will be coordinating & supporting both preventative educational programming and public education campaigns as required. They will be responsible for maintaining accurate records, participating in professional development opportunities, and staffing outreach spaces. They will be working collaboratively with other agencies, such as; Schools Plus, RCMP, Restorative Justice, Departments of Justice/Opportunities/Social Development, Early Intervention, Local Schools, Public Health, Mental Health & Addictions, and other community partners as required.

#### **Overview of Typical Duties:**

- · Counselling: Supportive and distress counselling.
- Crisis Intervention: Effectively using crisis intervention techniques to assess situations, & establish priorities.
- Needs Assessment and Action Planning: Providing assistance and support in identifying safety risks and immediate needs. Completing assessments, documentation, and any required reporting. Assisting clients in establishing priorities, safety plans, and identifying available resources. Providing ongoing support.
- Advocacy and Referral: Maintain a current knowledge of Community Resources and Partner Agencies. Serve as a support person for clients accessing such services and agencies. Court accompaniment may be required.
- Outreach/ Ongoing support: Provide outreach programs, support, and follow-up services to meet the related needs of persons in the community.
- Community Relations/ Public Education: Assist in the development and delivery of Public Education programs aimed at preventing domestic violence. Provide information, training, and education to increase public and professional awareness of gender-based violence. Participate in professional and community networks, collaborating with others as required.
- Professional Development: Participating in ongoing training and educational opportunities.
- Office Management and Day-to-Day Duties: Use of computer programs and databases, attending team meetings, and other government and community meetings as required.
- Credentials and Education:
- Bachelor's degree in social work, psychology, sociology, education, or counselling.
- English, French, and Mi'kmaq languages preferred.
- A thorough understanding of gender based violence, community resources, legislation, and government policies as they relate to gender based violence and the cycle of violence.
- Proficiency in public speaking and excellent communication skills. Comfortable delivering presentations to a variety of stakeholders. Work effectively within the community, with groups and partners.
- Excellent communication and computer skills.
- Must be responsible, highly motivated, able to take initiative, and comfortable working independently.
- Clean criminal record, child abuse registry, and vulnerable sector checks.


