NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

IN THE MATTER OF AN APPLICATION by the ST. PETER'S, SAMSONVILLE & AREA WATER UTILITY, on behalf of its Water Utility, for approval of amendment to its Schedule of Rates and Charges for Water and Water Services and amendments to its Schedule of Rules and Regulations. This matter will be considered in a public hearing as follows:

THE DATE AND LOCATION OF THE HEARING MAY CHANGE

If any Intervenor in this proceeding intends to file evidence, the timeline will be extended to accommodate this, and the hearing date will be rescheduled.

Depending on the circumstances, all or part of this public hearing may be held virtually, by video conferencing.

THE DATE, TIME AND LOCATION FOR THIS HEARING MAY BE CONFIRMED BY VISITING THE BOARD'S WEBSITE OR BY CONTACTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD.

Board Hearings are open to the public and you may participate as follows:

- You may speak at the hearing. You must notify the Board by Wednesday, June 25, 2025, of your request to speak.
- You may make written comments by sending a letter to the Clerk of the Board at P.O. Box 1692, Unit "M", Halifax, NS B3J 3S3, or by email at: board@novascotia.ca, or by fax at (902) 424-3919 by Wednesday, June 25, 2025.
- You may request formal standing as an Intervenor, subject to Board approval. This will allow you to present evidence or cross-examine witnesses. Your request must be received by the Board by Friday, May 30, 2025, and a copy of your written evidence by Wednesday, June 25, 2025.

Additional information about the matter is as follows:

- For a 5/8" meter, residential customer, the average current quarterly water bill is \$140.67, and it is proposed to increase to \$168.15 (19.5%) in 2025/26; \$177.56 (5.6%) in 2026/27; and to \$187.80 (5.8%) in 2027/28.
- The Utility is also requesting increases for other metered services ranging from 29.3% to 55.2% in 2025/26; 7.4% to 10.4% in 2026/27; and 6.4% to 7.4% in 2027/28.
- The annual fire protection charges to be paid by the Village of St. Peter's and the Municipality of the County of Richmond, currently \$173,937, is proposed to increase to \$178,158 (2.4%) in 2025/26; \$224,013 (25.7%) in 2026/27; and to \$243,212 (8.6%) in 2027/28.

Upon reviewing the Application, the Board, in its Decision, may determine that the proposed amendments should be as requested, higher, or lower.
