TAKE NOTICE THAT a meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Mulgrave was held at the Town Office, Mulgrave, Nova Scotia on the 17th day of February, 2026 and the following amendment to the Town of Mulgrave Sewer Charges By-Law was passed:

9. (1) The Municipality shall apply the sewer service charge at the rate of fifty percent (50%) to the standard assessment of the portion of AAN 03379043 assessed as "Commercial Exempt" (being the wharf portion of PID 35046309), commencing on April 1, 2025.

(2) Where the wharf portion ceases to be owned by Strait of Canso Superport Corporation Limited, the 50% application of the sewer service charge referred to in subsection 1 shall cease, and the owner of this property shall immediately be liable for the full amount as under this By-Law for the portion of the year then unexpired.
