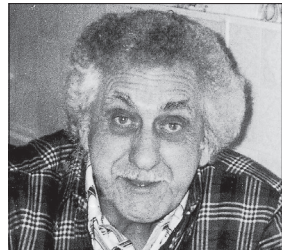


In loving memory of our Dad, "Hycinth Boudreau", who died June 9th, 1994.
