



Obituary

Marion Margaret Roulston

A 10th Anniversary Memorial will be held 30th July 6-8 pm at the Bonny Brae Senior Citizens Club, 14 Toulouse St., St. Peters, in memory of Marion Margaret Roulston, a longtime resident of Sporting Mountain and L'Ardoise areas who passed away from ovarian cancer at age 62 in Vancouver Palliative Care Hospice, BC on 15th April 2016, far from her heart's home but with her family around. Light refreshments and live fiddle music will be provided, as well as a showing of her photography.

Marion lived in Cape Breton from 1977-2014. Born in 1953 in Sackville NB to early Canadian art luminaries Emily Church (Faculty Ceramics, NSCA) and Max Roulston (Faculty, Applied Arts, Mt Allison Fine Arts), Marion briefly studied textile arts and fashion illustration at NSCAD in Halifax, before abandoning her studies and joining her first husband in the 70s counterculture movement in Vancouver, living also in the remote towns of Egmont and Gibsons and later northern Alberta. Her early life was marked by tragedy, losing her beloved younger brother Robert at age 12 from leukaemia and her beloved older sister Lyn not long after. In 1976-77, fleeing her disintegrating marriage, she took shelter and worked briefly on the Nettleton farm in Isle Madame before purchasing a wooded lot on Sporting Mtn, where she and her young family became members of the Oban-Seaview community.

Marion was a lifelong learner and in 1986 returned to St. Peters District High School to upgrade her education, then joining the St. Martha Nursing program in Antigonish. Faced with pressures of childcare, she ultimately withdrew from that program shortly before completion. She struggled in later years, as do so many traditional homemakers, with the challenge to re-enter the workforce. She divided her time between Vancouver, where she lived with her daughter, caring for her granddaughter and working various jobs, and returning to Cape Breton regularly to live in her beloved natural settings. She was fiercely independent and determined to be self-sufficient in life. She was a naturalist and firm proponent of back to the earth living and organic gardening; a talented craftswoman with advanced skills in weaving, sewing, spinning, quilting and knitting; and an avid reader of world literature. In her later years she took up photography. In 2014 she travelled to Vancouver to overwinter with her daughter and while there, was diagnosed with terminal stage 4 ovarian cancer and given only a short time to live. In the care of the BC Cancer Centre and by her own will she was able to extend this diagnosis by several years but sadly was never able to return to Cape Breton and passed in Vancouver in 2016.

Marion is survived by her daughters Miranda Joyce and Yarrow Gillis, her son Calvin Bradbury, her niece Emelie Klein, her nephew Aaron Roulston, and her granddaughters Morgan Desfosses and Maia and Alexandra Gillis.

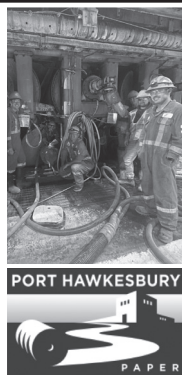
